We wanted to let you know what our plan will be if any child needs to isolate due to Covid19. Whether there is a local lockdown, partial closure of our school or individual self-isolation, our aim is for our pupils to:

- Receive a range of learning experiences and regular opportunities for feedback
- Continue to make good progress

Staff will aim to:

- Prioritise the well-being of our pupils and ensure they remain connected to the school community
- Use Seesaw as the primary communication tool supplemented by Zoom/ Teams/ BBC Bitesize and Oak Academy
- Support parents/ carers with a time allocation for each lesson
- Ensure the tasks are matched to the year curriculum and support pupils to make good progress
- Use a range of strategies and techniques to ensure learning is accessible to all
- Mirror the schools feedback policy when responding to tasks set
- Ensure that they maintain a manageable workload when school is open and remote learning is happening

Parents and Carers will aim to:
