SCHOOL UNIFORM

This is a reminder that our children are very smart at Guildford Grove and we expect all children to be in the **correct uniform every day**. They need black school shoes from Years 1-6. Reception and Nursery children wear trainers.

In Years 1-6, children wear trousers, skirts or pinafores. The children in Reception and Nursery wear jogging bottoms.

Everyone must wear their green sweatshirt or cardigan.

Now that we are in winter, the children need a coat and other winter garments like gloves, scarf and hat. It certainly can be very cold at this time of year.

On PE days, the children need to wear their green T-shirt with either leggings or jogging bottoms in a dark colour.
