### What is a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) ?

Each school must have appropriate senior members of staff to take lead responsibility for child protection.

Key aspects of the 'Designated Safeguarding Lead' role include:

- Making sure all staff are aware how to raise safeguarding concerns.
- Ensuring all staff understand the symptoms of child abuse and neglect.
- Referring any concerns to social care.
- Working together with parents/families to keep children safe.
- Maintaining accurate and secure child protection records.
- Raising awareness of the school's safeguarding policies and procedures, and ensuring they are implemented and reviewed regularly.
