Children will be following the **Master Reader** process to develop their reading comprehension and fluency.

THIS TERM'S MAIN TEXT WILL BE:

Everything Ancient Egypt (non-fiction)

WRITING

As part of our **Talk 4 Writing**, we will be learning how to create an action tale using the video 'Tadeo Jones'.

We will be learning how to use powerful verbs to inform the reader and use short sentences for dramatic effect.

MATHS

As mathematicians, the children will be learning to multiply and divide 2-digit by 2-digit numbers with and without exchange. We will learn how to measure accurately and to calculate perimeter.

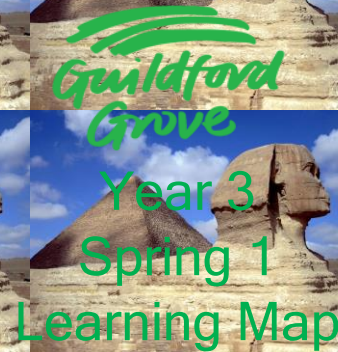
They will be learning our 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

SCIENCE: skeletons

How do skeletons help us move and protect us?

As scientists, the children will be learning about the functions of the skeleton and the parts of the body they protect. They will learn about vertebrates and invertebrates.

They will perform a pattern seeking inquiry to answer the question: Do taller people have larger hands? They will also make observations of a skeleton.



HISTORY – Ancient Egypt

What did the ancient Egyptians believe?

As historians, the children will learn about the gods and goddesses of ancient Egypt. They will learn about the role of the Nile in the creation of this ancient civilisation and study the pharaohs that ruled during this period of history.

Haslemere Museum visit: Mummification and artefacts.

PE & BSL

In **basketball**, the children will be learning about how to dribble, pass and score goals during a game. In **dance**, the children will respond to a musical stimulus and work cooperatively with a partner.

In **BSL**, they will learn their family tree.

ART: LANDSCAPE

What paint techniques are used to create landscape paintings?

Children will learn about Claude Monet and the local artist, Sidney Sime. They will experiment with various paint techniques and paint a landscape of the school field.

In **PSHE**, the children will be learning about safety and the changing body. They will focus on first aid and being kind online.

RE: What are important times for Jewish people?

In RE, they will learn about different Jewish festivals.
