READING

Children will be following the **Master Reader** process to develop their reading comprehension and fluency.

THIS TERM'S MAIN TEXT WILL BE:

SCIENCE: light

What are reflections and shadows?

As scientists, the children will be learning about the how shadows are formed, and which surfaces reflect light. They will also learn about different light sources.

In investigations they will record their results to show which objects create the best shadows and the properties of these objects.

WRITING

As part of our **Talk 4 Writing**, we will be learning how to create a descriptive tale using the book Zoo.

We will be learning how to use powerful verbs to inform the reader and use short sentences for dramatic effect.

MATHS

As mathematicians, the children will be learning to add and subtract fractions. They will learn to add and subtract different amounts of money. In time they will learn to tell the time to 5 minutes and 1 minute. They will be learning the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

HISTORY - Childhood

How have children's lives changed?

As historians, the children will focus on childhood in the Tudor times, the Victorian times and the modern era. They will identify continuity and change in these periods of history using primary and secondary sources. They will ask questions and research answers, using artefacts to find evidence.
