Children will be following the **Master Reader** process to develop their reading comprehension and fluency.

Letters from the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll

WRITING

As part of our **Talk 4 Writing**, we will be learning how to create suspense using the book 'A Christmas Carol' as inspiration.

We will also be learning how to structure and write non-chronological reports, recalling our knowledge of Victorian life.

MATHS

Using the White Rose maths scheme, the children will use their times table knowledge to recognize when fractions are, and are not, in their simplest form. They will recognise, read and write all metric measures for length, mass and capacity, understanding how to convert between these different units.

SCIENCE: ELECTRICITY

How do I create a more complex electrical circuit?

As scientists, the children will build on their knowledge from Year 4 and consider how bulbs, buzzers, cells and switches can be added to circuits; learning how to show these with symbols.

They will work in pairs to set up fair and comparative tests and consider how to evaluate the success of their experiments.
