SCIENCE: STATES OF MATTER

What are solids, liquids and gases?

As scientists, the children will continue to build on their everyday knowledge of solids, liquids and gases. They will investigate boiling and evaporation. They will also learn about condensation and revisit their learning on the water cycle. They will work in pairs to ask scientific questions and identify patterns in their investigations.

WRITING
