

PHONICS

Children will be following the 'Little Wandle' phonics programme to learn early reading skills.

They will learn the following sounds:

s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,ck,e,u,r,h,b,f,l,ff,ll,ss,j,v,w,x,y,z,zz,qu,ch,sh,th,ng,nk.

MATHS

As mathematicians, the children will use the **White Rose Maths** to match and sort different objects. They will work with the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 which will include finding and representing the numbers, looking at the composition of the numbers and comparing the numbers.

LITERACY

As part of our **Talk 4 Writing**, we are learning to retell these traditional tales:

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

This term, the children will learn early Science, Geography and R.E skills.

They will begin to learn Science through observing changes in the environment and seasons. They will begin to explore Geography through making and using simple maps and also explore R.E through the story of the first Christmas.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

In PE, children will learn to move around a space safely, stop safely, develop control when using equipment and work co-operatively with a partner. In class, they will also learn to develop their pencil control and cutting skills.

This term, children will learn how to manage their feelings and emotions using the zones of regulation.
